



INTRODUCTION

Extension Type: Ground Floor Side & First Floor Rear

Size: 20 SQM (extension only)


Duration: 16 Weeks

Budget: £74,000 + VAT

The Milton Road project, located in a Lambeth conservation area, was carefully designed to comply with local guidelines and respect the area's planning history. The first-floor rear extension aligns with neighbouring outriggers, while a ground-level side extension transformed a dark, narrow space into a bright kitchen and dining area. The reconfiguration also added a WC and utility room in a previously unused area. Velux windows, large rear doors, and Crittall-style folding doors with white frames were incorporated to maximise natural light and complement the 19th-century terraced house's original character.



KEY FEATURES

01 Folding Doors:

The Crittall-style folding doors add a modern touch, seamlessly linking the indoor space to the garden while complementing the 19thcentury home's original sash windows.


02 Velux Windows

Velux windows were added to the side extension roof, flooding the interior with natural light and enhancing the sense of space and brightness throughout the home.

03 Belfast Sink:

A Belfast sink was installed in the kitchen, offering a classic, robust design that complements the home's traditional aesthetic while providing practicality and durability in the busy kitchen space.

04 Kitchen:

Fitted floor to ceiling cabinetry optimise space and enhance the 19th century charm and aesthetic.

05 Kitchen Island:


A kitchen island provides additional storage space and doubles up as a dining table.
